Award Categories

Nominations can be made by any Blackpool Council tenant or leaseholder and you can make as many nominations as you like. It is important that you try and include as much information as possible on the nomination form to help the judges make their decision.

In some categories, BCH staff who work closely with the local community may also make a nomination.

Good Neighbour Award

We are seeking nominations for tenants and leaseholders who have made a positive difference to a neighbour or neighbours. This could be offering support, shopping, running errands or any other kind of helping hand.

Community Group of the Year

We are seeking nominations for community groups who have made a positive difference in their local area. This could be things such as developing community spirit, encouraging wider participation, holding group activities, empowering others or working with agencies to tackle local problems.

Outstanding Contribution to the Community

We are seeking nominations for an individual that has made a positive impact within the local community in which they live or work. This positive impact could be things such as speaking up for others, developing new community projects, organising community events, securing funding for the local community or working with partner agencies to improve the local area.

Young Person Award (Under 21)

We are seeking nominations for a young person who has shown a real commitment to helping people within or improving the local community. This could be by volunteering for community activities, helping other people, organising activities, inspiring others or speaking up for other young people or their community.

Community Project of the Year

We are seeking nominations for a project that has had a significant positive impact on your community. This could be a project that tackles anti-social behaviour, provides activities for young people, has improved the look of a local area, provides support to the elderly or helps families.

Mature Persons Award (Over 60)

We are seeking nominations for an older person who has shown a real commitment to helping people within or improving the local community. This could be volunteering for community activities, helping out at or running a social event, helping other people or speaking up and representing other older people within their community.

The Agency / Partnership Award

We are seeking nominations for an agency or partner that has worked with Blackpool Coastal Housing and had a positive impact on the community or who, through their work and activities, have improved the circumstances of individuals or families. This could be an agency who works closely with young people or families, a contractor who has funded and carried out community project, an agency that works with and cares for older people, an agency or partner that has helped to reduce crime or promote safety or one that has helped to increase local community spirit, making your local neighbourhood a place where you are proud to live.

BCH Staff Award

We are seeking nominations for a Blackpool Coastal Housing Staff member who you feel has gone the extra mile in order to make a difference to you, your family or your community. This could be a staff member who has provided over and above the service you expected, a staff member who has worked closely with you to achieve a positive result or a staff member that you feel has consistently helped you and provided a quality service.
